High-Capacity Transit Services and Stations

High-Capacity Transit (HCT) refers to the following public transportation modes: Metrorail, commuter rail, light rail, streetcar, and bus rapid transit (BRT). These transit modes are designed for carrying a larger number of passengers than other transit modes, such as local bus service or microtransit. HCT often operates within dedicated travel space and at higher speeds in order to improve service efficiency and customer experience. Within the National Capital Region, there are various HCT operators, and their networks consist of the following (centerline) mileage by mode.

- 129 miles of Metrorail
- 173 miles of MARC and VRE commuter rail
- 14 miles of Bus Rapid Transit
- 2 miles of Streetcar
